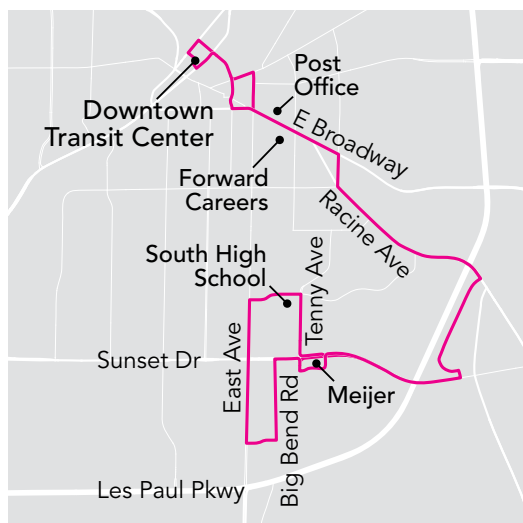

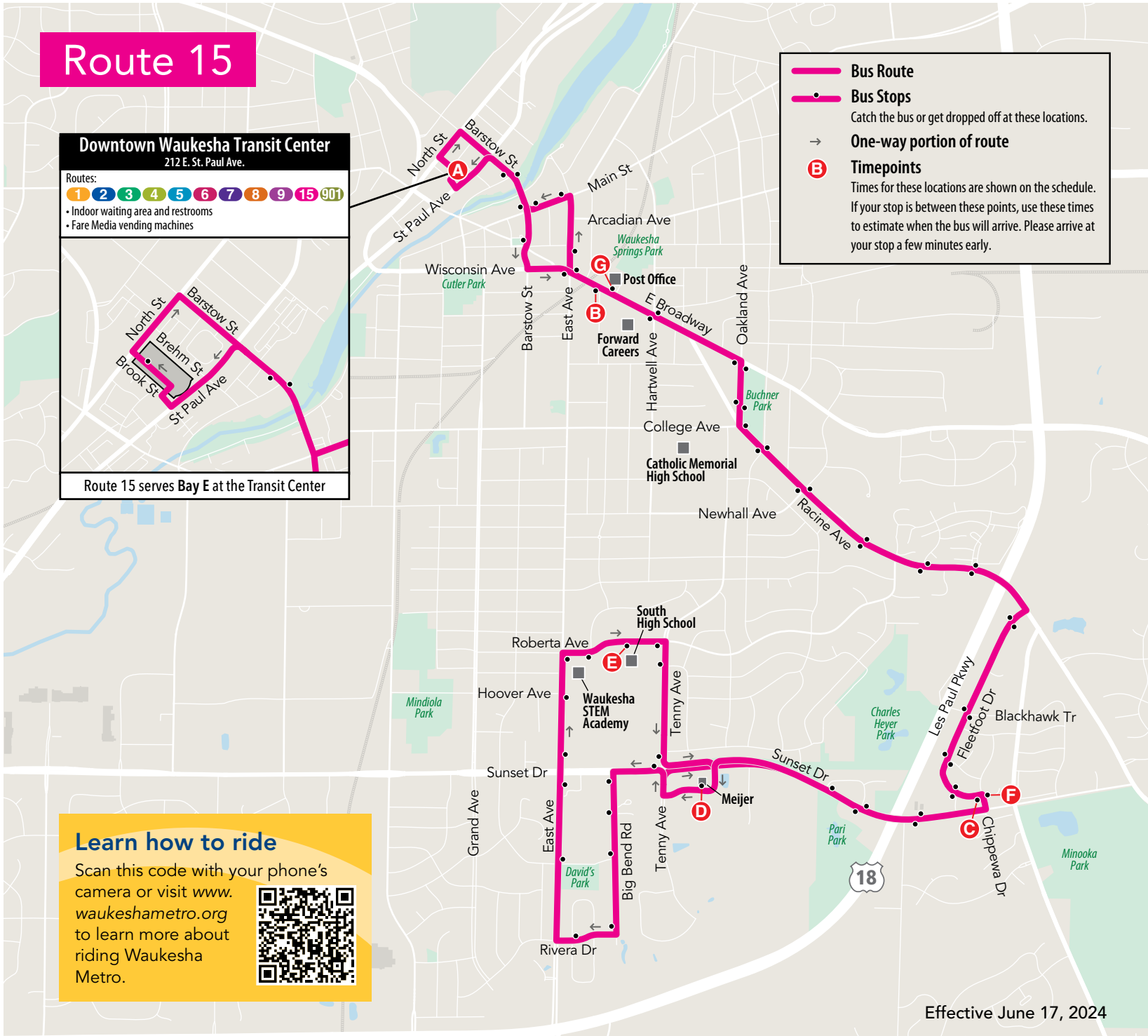

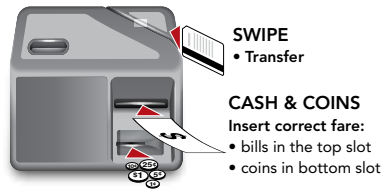

Paying your fare

As you board the bus, pay your fare with the **Umo app** or a **WisGo card** by using the validator near the front door:



Or pay your fare with **cash** using the farebox next to the driver:



Transfers

A 90 minute transfer is automatically encoded on your WisGo card or Umo app from the first tap (payment of fare) on a Waukesha Metro or MCTS bus. When paying your fare in cash, ask the driver for a transfer if you plan to use another bus to complete your trip. A Metro transfer is valid for a ride on any other Waukesha Metro route for 90 minutes from your first trip. Visit waukeshametro.org for information about transfers to Waukesha County and Milwaukee County routes.

Youth Ages 5-18 with valid elementary or secondary student ID	\$1.25
Senior (65+)/Disabled Medicare ID or Metro ID Required	\$1.00

Electronic Payment

Fares may be paid with a WisGo Card or the Umo app by using the validator near the door.



Fare Capping

Never pay more than the daily, weekly, or monthly limit when you use the Umo app or a WisGo card.

Instead of purchasing daily, weekly, or monthly passes, the system stops charging once you've reached the max. Once you've reached your cap, all rides and transfers are free for the rest of the day, week or month.

Pago electrónico

Las tarifas se pueden pagar con una tarjeta WisGo o la aplicación Umo utilizando el validador cerca de la puerta.

Límites de tarifa

Nunca pague más que el límite diario, semanal o mensual cuando use la aplicación Umo o una tarjeta WisGo.

En lugar de comprar pases diarios, semanales o mensuales, el sistema deja de cargar una vez que has alcanzado el máximo. Una vez que haya alcanzado su límite, todos los viajes y traslados serán gratuitos durante el resto del día, la semana o el mes.
