

Alternatives to Routes 904 & 905

Unfortunately due to the continued low ridership and increased costs over the past several years, Waukesha County Routes 904 & 905 will no longer operate after Friday, September 26, 2025. The following are suggested alternatives available vs. commuting alone. Please consider:

1. Waukesha Metro Route 1

Waukesha Metro Route 1 operates every 23 minutes from the Transit Center in downtown Waukesha with stops at Goerkes Corners and Brookfield Square. Route 1 connects with the Milwaukee County Transit System Connect 1 BRT line with service on Wisconsin Ave in downtown Milwaukee. Go to: waukeshametro.org or ridemcts.com for more information.
